

Operating Guidelines Rookie of the Year

The “Rookie of the Year” award will be given at the discretion of the Board of Directors on a yearly basis.

This award is given in recognition of a member’s commitment to the Club by participating as a committee chair, officer, board of director, driving or hosting an outing, attending Club meetings. The list below is not inclusive of all commitments that can be considered.

- 1) The Board will review eligibility and consideration for “Rookie of the Year” candidate(s) at the November board meeting.
- 2) The timeframe for participation for this award should not be structured, the “Rookie” range can be anywhere from 12-18 months from membership date.
- 3) If award is to be given, it can be as simple as a Club “Rookie of the Year” patch, or gift for which a budget has been set.
- 4) If patch is to be given, advise Vice President as soon as possible as they are responsible for ordering patches. A disk with this patch has been established – a date change of the year is all that is necessary.
- 5) This award is to be presented to the recipient(s) at the February Anniversary celebration.
- 6) Budget allocation is established at the January board meeting. For current year spending allotment, contact the Treasurer.
