

Hello,

My name is Aaron Perez, Husband of Katy Loomis Perez. We are selling her 1929 Ford Model A Sport Coupe. It has been in my wife's family for 3 generations, starting with her Fraternal Grandmother's brother (wife's great Uncle). It then went to her Grandmother, then passed down to her Uncle, who then gave it to his son (wife's cousin), at which point we purchased it from her cousin in 2008.

We are in the process of moving and have decided to sell it. We reached out to her relatives which are not interested in purchasing it. I am a mechanic by trade and have performed some repairs on it and have it in running condition, though it is still in need of some repairs and restoration.

It is in original stock form (brakes, suspension, and power train), though the rumble seat hatch is made of fiberglass. The great uncle used the Model A for his plumbing business and had turned the rumble seat area into a wooden bed for his tools. When my wife's Uncle got it he paid for a restoration to put the rumble seat back in, but chose a fiberglass lid. The interior and rumble seats were re-upholstered at some point, as was the vinyl top. I had the wheels powder coated red, and replaced all 5 of the inner tubes and tires, though that was over 10 years ago. The vehicle has been a California car at least since it has been in the Loomis family. The family unfortunately did not keep any service records or pictures off the vehicle but we have the names of all the parties that owned it going back to her great uncle. It was also in many parade's in Weaverville CA, it's long time home until being sold to us.
